Cricket field:

The playground's centre is where the cricket pitch is located. The pitch measures 3.6 metres in width and 20 metres in length from stump to stump. Both ends of the crease measure 1.2 metres. The cricket field is flat and well-kept. Three stumps and bails are driven into the ground on either end of the pitch. For the students' use, there are five sets of cricket bats and one box of balls available in the store room.

Volleyball court:

The volleyball court is provided to the students on the right side of the playing area. The court is 18 metres long overall and 9 metres wide. The attack line is 3 metres away from the centre line on both sides of a court that is 9 by 9 metres in size. For male volleyball players, the net is 7 feet tall, whereas it is 6.5 feet tall for female players. Using a chalk pit, the markings are made. Two good-condition nets and two volley balls are kept in the storage rooms for use.

Throwball (for Girls)

Next to the Panchaganga hostel, there is a throwball court. The court is 9 metres in width and 18 metres in length overall. A single court is 9 by 9 metres in size, with the attack line on either side of the middle line being 3 metres apart. Pits of chalk are used for markings, and one throwball and a net are always kept in the storage room for play.

Dodgeball

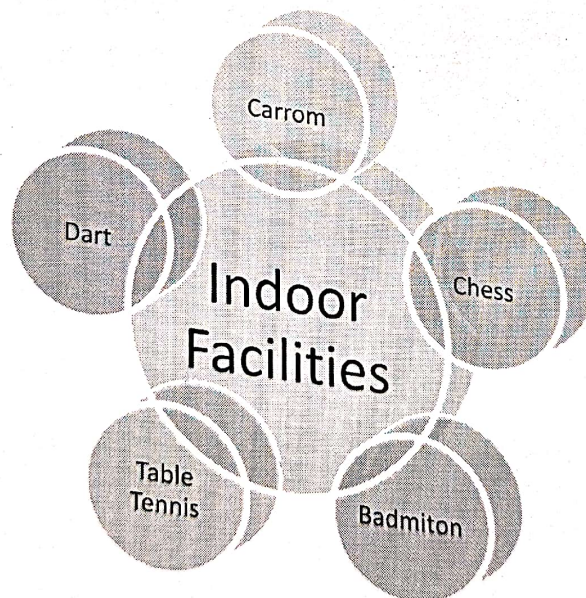
The court measures a circle with a radius of 5 metres and a diameter of 10 metres, and a restriction line to not cross for fouls is made available on the ground. One dodgeball is given for the girls to practise.

Football

On the ground, there is a football field that is about 50 metres long and 40 metres wide. With four corners and a 25-metre centre line on each side. A goal post erected in the playground is roughly 6 feet broad and 7 feet tall. For the boys, there is one football that is in good shape.

Tug of war:

A rope of about 20 metres is used to play tug of war on a ground measuring 18.5 metres.



Badminton-

The boys' and girls' hostels each have one badminton court. Students may utilise the shuttle and cock nets, which are both kept in the store room.

Table tennis-

The college gym is where table tennis is played, and it has a professional table measuring 2.7 metres long, 1.5 metres wide, and 0.7 metres high. Four sets of Table tennis bats and balls are kept in the gym for use.

Carrom

The recreational room, which is close to the central mess, has four carrom boards. The coins and boards are maintained in the hall for use.

Chess and Darts-

The recreation area has four chess boards, and the pieces and boards are kept in the store room for use. Two Dart boards are also kept in the hall for use.

Cultural activities:

All the cultural activities at the college are conducted in the auditorium. The auditorium room is well ventilated and has adequate natural light. The auditorium is also well-equipped with-ICT facilities. An LCD Projector and audio system with microphones are made available for the events. The hall is completely illuminated, with two focus lights of 50 watts on the stage and nine par lights of 20 watts in the rest of the audience. The auditorium is filled with a vibrant array of cultural activities, providing a platform for students to showcase their talents and creativity. The space comes alive with a wide range of engaging and entertaining events that captivate the audience and encourage students to showcase their talent.

Various activities like singing, dancing, quizzes, best out of waste, mehndi competitions, antakshari, funfairs, etc. are carried out annually during the annual days of college.
